

Freedom Boat Owners Tournament 2022 Rules and Regulations

1 to 3 Man Teams

Live or dead weigh-in

Registration will be online at **www.freedomboatsusa.com** or at the captains meeting the Friday before the event

All Texas Parks & Wildlife's regulations apply.

Anyone under the age of 18 must fish with a legal guardian

Stringer consists of:

3 Speckled Trout

2 Redfish

1 Flounder

- Trout being weighed in must be from 15 to 25 inches with only one Fish per angler allowed over 25 inches. You may have your legal Texas limit in possession which dictates that each angler may only retain one trout over 25 inches. If two fish over 25 inches are landed by the same angler, one must be released immediately. Redfish must measure between 20-28 inches, no oversized redfish. Ice may not be used to shrink oversize fish. Main stringer is 3 Trout with only 2 redfish.
- If 3 anglers are fishing in the same boat, they must form 1 team. 3 anglers per boat max. If a person is not in the tournament, they may not be in the boat during tournament times. The only acceptation is if your boat is designated to be a camera boat.

Measuring Fish

The silver Check it Stick on a slant board is the official measuring device It is not required but recommended you use the same device.

Fish will be measured by placing the nose/bottom jaw of the fish against the "zero" end of the stick and sweeping the tail to the middle of the check it stick to determine the longest point of the fish.

No fish may be altered in anyway. Any fish that appear altered or have cut, altered, deformed tails are subject to review by the weighmaster. If there is question on a fish, the angler may be disqualified or polygraphed. Failure of a polygraph in this matter can result in being banned from any future tournaments.



Fishing Methods

All fish must be caught by rod and reel with artificial lures. All fish must be caught during the day of the event during allotted times. Adults can cast for kids but the child angler must reel in their own fish. No sharing or pooling of fish. No natural (live) baits, dead or prepared baits are allowed on the boat or in possession during the event. Scented and spray on scents are legal for lure only events. Anglers may only use one rod at a time, no trolling or multiple rods. A cast must be fully retrieved before another is made.

Alcohol

The boat operator may not consume alcohol until he/she reaches the weigh in parking lot. If you feel you are in contention for the win please do not consume alcohol until after the polygraph.

• Polygraph and Protests

All winners will be subject to a polygraph test onsite or at a later date at the request of only the weigh master or tournament directors before collecting their prize.

Protests made by contestants must be made no later than 30 minutes after the last fish are weighed. Written protest must be accompanied by a \$250 deposit, which will be refunded if the rules committee up holds the protest.

Any angler not following any of these rules can be disqualified from this or any future events.

The weigh master and staff have the right to retain any fish for further inspection.

• Weather Cancellations

If the weather looks inclimate, it is the angler's responsibility to check the website or call 832-474-1685 to see if the event is on. If you do not see or hear a message, the event has not been cancelled. If it is cancelled, messages will be posted by 12am and, information will be posted on Facebook.

• Times-

Weigh in sites and take off times will be announced on Facebook

There is no morning check in. You can launch from any location as long as you are in line before weigh in ends.

You may fish up until weigh in, however you must be in line with your fish before the official end time of the tournament, or you will be disqualified.

In the event of a tie, the first team to weigh-in shall be the winner.

Communications

No radios or cell phones (including Text Messages) may be used to contact or be contacted



by anyone with any fishing related questions or information until the angler arrives at the boat ramp. If someone sends you a text message asking how you did, do not reply!! This will include Twitter, Facebook, Snapchat, etc... The best thing to do is not post, comment, email, tweet on anything of that nature until you have arrived at the weigh-in parking lot. If an emergency occurs, please contact the proper authorities and contact the tournament director.

• Tournament Boundaries

Boundaries, Beach and Jetty fishing is permitted up to ½ mile off each structure for either event. You may fish any Texas bay systems. Any person fishing out of the boundaries will be disqualified. Behind weirs/dams or private ponds or lakes are off-limits. Along with any locations that you know are off limits but may have access, or have fallen/ signs

• Fishing Distances

Contestants fishing as a team must fish no farther than 300 yards apart if wading from a boat. Waders must stay within 300 yards of their boat.

Waders or boaters must remain 75 yards away from another wader or boat in competition unless passing through a navigable channel. If closer, they must be OK'ed by the other angler, if one angler is waved in all anglers may enter the area. Use courtesy rule with non-competitors. Anglers must not exceed 5mph when within 50 yards of another boat, unless passing through a navigable channel

• Captain's meetings/Optional divisions: Freedom Boats captain's meeting-onsite registration will be between 6-8pm the Friday before the tournament. Venue — Sharkie's Bar & Grill, Port O'Connor, TX - TBD.

Captain's meeting will start at 7:15pm

A captain must be designated at the captains meeting or upon registration.

This is not a mandatory captains' meetings. It is advised they everyone attend the meeting in order to ask questions, and get valuable information about the tournament. We will also be giving out shirts and surprise giveaways during the captains' meetings.

• Payouts / Entry Fees

100% Payback

Entry Fee is \$200 Per. Person - 100% Payback (check website for age categories)

- Main division (payout will be announced after completion of the registration)
- Side pots will be \$25 per person Big Trout



- Redfish with the most spots
- Big Flounder
- Big Ugly
